CUMRU TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED TRANSFER OF LIQUOR LICENSE JANUARY 17, 2017

The Public Hearing for transfer of a liquor license, of the Cumru Township Board of Commissioners, was called to order by President Ruth A. O'Leary at 6:47 p.m. Other Commissioners in attendance were Vice President Edward L. Gottschall, Sheri Hoover, Lorri K. Swan, and Tony J. Sacco. Also attending were Township Manager Jeanne E. Johnston, Township Solicitor Michael A. Setley, Chief of Police Madison Winchester, Fire Chief James A. Beane, Superintendent of Public Works Robert McNichols, Jr., Business Administrator Peggy A. Carpenter, and Secretary Latoya Procopio.

Mr. Setley stated that the public hearing was being held pursuant to the Pennsylvania Liquor Code. The applicant to receive the license was Gino Billeci for Gino's Grill, located at 2233 Lancaster Pike. The liquor license was currently owned by Eberhart's Tavern, No. R-14135.

The applicant was represented by Atty. Sal Folino. Mr. Folino informed the Board that Cumru Township is allotted 5 licenses and this would be the 6th. Mr. Folino presented an affidavit from the property owner stating no objection to the transfer. He also submitted a copy of the PLCB application.

Mr. Billeci stated that Gino's Grill seats 64 people at tables, with a bar service for 10 people. The hours are 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Tuesday through Thursday, 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday, and 1100 a.m. to 9 p.m Sunday. There is no take out and no outdoor seating. Mr. Billeci runs the Blue Marsh Canteen and there has been no problem with that establishment's liquor license.
